Why are municipal regions attracting investors?

Germany has 81 cities with at least 100,000 inhabitants and **one-third of Europe's 15 highest metropolitan area GDPs**. Thriving sectors include new energy, environmental, IT, and security infrastructure.

Why is Germany the perfect business location?

The **decentralised system of government** means exciting ideas
and approaches, from public-private
partnerships to innovative funding
models, can be tested with less
outside interference.

Will local governments embrace digital solutions?

Germany's recent Online Access Act requires all 11,000 local governments to make their administrative services digitally accessible by the end of 2022.

How strong will funding be?

95 lighthouse projects ("Modellprojekte Smart Cities") throughout the country will be funded in five separate rounds to the tune of €850 million in total.

How about an example?

The **Wolfsburg city** government and public utilities provider are expanding the local fiber-optic network to connect 7,100 homes, 2,600 business, and 200 public authorities.

And another one?

The **Future City Ulm 2030 project** uses data to develop innovative projects like bike sharing, autonomous living for senior citizens, and a more creative and flexible city administration.



And one to finish off?

Hamburg is pioneering new, sustainable mobility solutions in the form of intelligent traffic systems. One project involves testing a regular, electric, autonomous mini-bus service.
